

Unusual Fairway Wood Used to Finish in Top-10 at Champions Tour

A Vero Beach, FL golfer with 6 years on the PGA Tour and a Venezuela Open victory under his belt, chose a very peculiar fairway wood this past weekend at the Champions Tour. The world's first all-titanium Beta face fairway wood was used to capture 9th place in the Champions Tour Dick's Sporting Goods Open.

Alpha Golf, famous for its 6 ReMax World Long Drive Titles, created the V5 Hi-COR Fairway Wood. With an all-titanium head and a Beta-Ti face with TiCN coating, the V5 Hi-COR caught the attention of Tour players who replaced their steel fairway woods.
