## **Alpha Golf C830.2 Driver**

### **Rating: 5 out of 5**

The C830.2 Driver is one of the latest offerings from Alpha Golf Clubs and improves on the C830 driver. The Alpha drivers are very popular on the Long Drivers of America (LDA) circuit. Alpha Golf drivers were the preferred driver for six of the top-10 ranked hitters in 2004, and used by 2004 LDA Tour champion Danny Lurette. The C830.2 titanium driver is designed to deliver better performance to every golfer's game.

Alpha touts this driver as one of the most durable drivers in the world. In fact, no professional long driver has ever broken a C830.2 – and believe me, these guys swing HARD. That says a lot about how tough these drivers are.

Overall, the look is beautiful in its simplicity. It features a large black head with a black shaft. The underside of the club is clean and uncluttered. The C830.2 sets up nicely at address giving you confidence before you get ready to swing.

Prior to taking my first hit with the C830.2, I assumed that I would have a difficult time with it because I figured that this club was meant for long distance hitters with a much higher swing speed than mine. Much to my surprise, I couldn't have been more wrong. From the get-go, I tattooed the ball with this club! Not only was I getting more distance than I could have ever imagined, I was for the most part hitting it as straight as an arrow. I hit this driver more consistently than any other driver I've tested so far. Even my Senior Citizen father hit the heck out of this club and his swing speed is much lower than mine.

When you hit the ball on the sweet spot of this club the ball takes off like a rocket with a very high trajectory. I was getting at least 20-30 yards more distance than my old Great Big Bertha driver. I am definitely not known among my golfing buddies as a “big” hitter – I'm usually in the 265-270 range. With the C830.2, I was consistently hitting the 290-yard mark (I even hit one over 300 yards and that is a long way for me).

I also assumed that this club wouldn't be as forgiving as some of the other clubs on the market. That is not the case with the C830.2 as off-center shots strayed very little from their intended target. So it has distance and it has forgiveness. It has to lack control, right? Wrong. I was easily able to work the ball from right-to-left and left-to-right.

### **Summary**

**This is by far THE best driver you’ve never heard of.** If you want a driver that has it all: ultimate distance, superior control, and awesome forgiveness - you have to try this club. I know it will be in my bag for a long time to come. The Alpha C830.2 retails for around \$329 – a remarkable value for what you get.
